The instant civil writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction especially a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to enroll the petitioner in the department as Home Guard with continuity in service with back wages as the service of the petitioner has been terminated illegally without issuing any show cause notice/charge-sheet to the petitioner and without granting any opportunity of personal hearing. In this regard, a representation dated 20.01.2022 (Annexure P-3) has been given by the petitioner to the respondents but till date no decision has been taken thereon.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and submits that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the legal notice of the petitioner. Let a copy of the entire

writ petition be served upon him within three days.

The present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 20.01.2022 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, failing which the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to deposit costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
