Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.208 dated 30.12.2021 registered under Sections 379, 411, 420, 482, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that FIR in this case was registered against the petitioner and one Sahil on the basis of secret information and thereafter, one stolen motorcycle was recovered from possession of co-accused Sahil. He further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in light of previous order of interim bail passed by this Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh has not disputed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and further submits that recovery has already been effected in this case and the

petitioner is not required by the police for purpose of further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 25.3.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
