ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

This Court had granted interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner on 29.03.2022. Pursuant to that, the petitioner is stated to have joined the investigation and status report has also been filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sonipat.

It has been mentioned in the paragraph 5 of the Status report that on 20.09.2020, the complainant made a supplementary statement wherein she stated that her son was murdered only by Sandeep @ Patwari and Vishal, and that there was no involvement of Jalbir @ Dalbir (the present petitioner and Parvinder @ Kala). The investigation was also conducted in this regard and villagers were also joined. The investigation does not reveal any incriminating evidence against the petitioner.

Given above, there is no justification for denial of bail to the petitioner, and the interim order dated 29.03.2022 is made absolute.
