The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 & 2 to restrain respondent No.3 from helping respondents No.4 & 5 and to direct respondent No.3 to register FIR against respondents No.4 & 5 for as mentioned in the representation dated 22.04.2021 (Annexure P-8).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case directions be issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh Police Headquarter, Sector 9, Chandigarh, to decide the representation dated 22.04.2021 (Annexure P-8) within the time bound manner.

The prayer being innocuous is not opposed.

Given above, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh Police Headquarter, Sector 9, Chandigarh, is directed to decide the representation by passing a speaking order within ***ten working days*** from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, he shall be at liberty to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

Petition is allowed to the extent above. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
