This is Criminal Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the respondents to extend the petitioners' two weeks parole further for 3 months under Section 3(1)(a) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988, to enable him to serve his mother who remained hospitalized w.e.f. 12.03.2022 to 17.03.2022.
