The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners which is in danger at the hands of private respondents.

Notice of motion was issued in this case on 27.04.2018.

Pursuant thereto a reply dated has been filed by way of affidavit of Om Parkash, HPS Assistant Commissioner of Police Kalka, Panchkula on behalf of respondents-State. The relevant para of reply is as under:-

“That notices were issued to the petitioners to enquire the complaint submitted by respondent No.5 but petitioners are not joining the inquiry. No harassment was caused to the petitioners. Petitioners are leveling false allegations of harassment against the police. It is further submitted that representation dated 23.04.2018 was not received in the office of the answering respondent.

6. That in view of the submissions made above the present petition may kindly be dismissed in the interest of

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justice being devoid of any merits.”

In view of the aforesaid, learned State counsel submits that this petition been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

Learned counsel for the petitioners having gone through the copy of the reply also affirms the same.
