This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.306 dated 02.07.2020 registered under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 506, 201 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sector-8, Faridabad, District Faridabad and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to take up all the points as raised in the present petition and available to them, at the relevant stage before the trial Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as

withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts as stated by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioner No.2 is a lady and she is resident of Uttar Pradesh whereas the proceedings in the case are going on in District Faridabad, thus, the personal appearance of petitioner No.2 before the trial Court is exempted, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) Petitioner No.2 shall be represented through her counsel;
- ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
- iii) shall not dispute her identity as accused;
- iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in her absence but in the presence of her counsel;
- v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court;
- vi) any other condition which the trial Court may impose.
