As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.1,75,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellant in full & final satisfaction of the claim. Learned counsel for the appellant has further pointed out that the name of appellant-Sham Singh has been spelled as Seaim Singh in the Aadhaar Card and he has placed on record the self attested copy of the Aadhaar Card and a copy of the cheque to support that the account number of the appellant is in the name of Seaim Singh. The father's name of Sham Singh and Seaim Singh is the same, and Sham Singh and Seaim Singh is one and the same person and therefore, the cheque be issued in the name of Seaim Singh in the sum of Rs.1,75,000/-. Correction in the memo of parties is accordingly made.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.1,75,000/- favouring the appellant-Seaim Singh S/o Sucha Singh with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 03.10.2022. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
