In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the benefits under the Assured Career Progression Scheme after completion of 9 and 14 years of service, have not been released despite its being sanctioned.

After notice of motion, the respondents have appeared and have brought to the notice of this Court an order dated 11.05.2022 wherein, it has been mentioned that the benefits have already been released to the petitioner and his pay has already been refixed.

That being so, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition. However, in case the petitioner feels that any of the relief, for which he is still entitled for, has not been released by the respondents, he can make a representation to the respondents claiming the said benefit and in case, any such representation is filed, the respondents

will decide the said representation within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

The present petition is disposed of in above terms.
