JAISHREE THAKUR J. (ORAL)

1. This is a petition that has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the official respondents to step up the pay of the petitioners at par with respondent No.4, who is junior to the petitioners, in view of the order dated 15.11.2021. In this regard, a legal notice dated 10.01.2022 (Annexure P-7) has been given by the petitioners to the official respondents but till date no decision has been taken thereon.

2. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

3. Mr. T.V.S. Lehal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice for the official respondents and submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the legal notice of the petitioners. Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

5. Without commenting on merits of the case, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to take a decision on the legal notice dated 10.01.2022 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioners in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, failing which the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to deposit costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
