Prayer in the petition is for quashing of criminal complaint No. 287/2010 dated 06.05.2010 (Annexure P-6) and summoning order dated 20.09.2014 (Annexure P-7) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar, whereby the petitioner were summoned to face the trial for offence under Section 420 IPC and all the subsequent proceedings therefrom.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that with the intervention of the respectable persons, the matter has been compromised between the parties on 16.12.2022.
