The matter has been taken up through video conferencing *via* Webex facility due to Covid-19 pandemic situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.58, dated 06.03.2021, under Sections 452 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 8 of the POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Partap Nagar.

Vide order dated 25.03.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 25.03.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel was directed on 06.12.2021, to verify allegations raised by the complainant, regarding which on instructions from ASI Binder Masih, he submits that the police has verified the said allegations of the complainant and found that there is no truth in the same. He has also affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the respondent No.2/complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, interim order dated 25.03.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
