The prayer in the present petition is that the LTC for the block year 2016-2019 has not been released to him without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the petitioner was entitled for release of the same immediately, however, without giving any valid justification the said benefits have been withheld by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance, as has been raised in the present writ petition, has also been raised in the legal notice dated 15.11.2021 (Annexure P-8), which is still pending consideration with the respondents authorities and the petitioner will be satisfied in case direction is given to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 15.11.2021 (Annexure P-8) in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 15.11.2021 (Annexure P-8) in a time bound manner.

Without going into the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition or in the legal notice, the respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 15.11.2021 (Annexure P-8) within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefits, the same be also extended to him within a period of next four weeks.
