[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 08.09.2020 in CWP No.13806 of 2020.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.13806 of 2020 was disposed of vide order dated 08.09.2020 by directing the Deputy Commissioner, Barnala to decide representation dated 22.06.2020 and take necessary steps in respect thereto with regard to the poultry farm situated in the residential area.

[3] Learned Addl. AG, Punjab, has filed reply along with report (Annexure R-1/1) dated 12.07.2021 as well as letter (Annexure R-1/2) dated 28.07.2021 and contends that representation dated 22.06.2020 filed by the petitioner has been decided and the poultry farm which was located in residential area has been closed.

[4] Learned Addl. AG, Punjab, states that copy of the reply has

[6] In view of decision on the representation submitted by the petitioner, as well as closure of the poultry farm in the residential area, no action is called for against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
