1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 30.11.2021, in CWP-24201-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 30.11.2021, reveals that CWP-24201-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 17.03.2021, filed by the petitioner, within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and inform the petitioner of the decision taken thereon.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has filed reply along with speaking order Annexure R/1 dated 28.03.2022, rejecting the claim as contained in the representation filed by the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to

withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 28.03.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
