Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a direction to official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as she apprehends imminent threat of elimination from respondent No.4.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner came in contact with respondent No.4, who was residing in her neighbourhood and on the pretext of marriage, respondent No.4 developed physical relations with her. Counsel submits that when the petitioner became pregnant, instead of marrying her, he started pressurizing her to terminate her pregnancy. Counsel submits that before approaching this Court, the petitioner has submitted a representation (Annexure P-4) to the

Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, respondent No.2, but the same has not been attended to. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the representation (Annexure P-4).

Having considered the request of counsel for the petitioner, but without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, respondent No.2 to examine the representation (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner and to take suitable action thereon as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of this order as well as representation (Annexure P-4) be communicated to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, respondent No.2 to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
