The petitioner's passport has been impounded for concealment of material particulars. In the passport, her marital status was mentioned as 'single' whereas in fact she is married. The action was taken on a complaint filed by her estranged husband.

The petitioner now wants re-issuance of passport with corrected marital status but as yet she has not made an application for re-issuance of passport and thus, no cause of action has arisen in her favour.

Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file an application for re-issuance of a passport.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforementioned liberty.
