Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.87 dated 02.07.2021, registered for offences under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar, Punjab, Annexure P-1.

As per office report, notice issued to respondent No.2 has been served, however, there is no representation on her behalf.

Upon instructions received from ASI, Daljit Singh, State counsel submits that the petitioner, who is the husband of the complainant-respondent No.2, has joined the investigation pursuant to order dated 24.03.2022 passed by this Court and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

Order dated 24.03.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Petition is allowed.
