Prayer in this petition is for quashing of the order dated 17.05.2014 passed by the learned trial Court, vide which the petitioners were declared proclaimed offenders in FIR No.151 dated 18.06.2009, registered under Sections 153-A, 120-B IPC, Section 3 of the Prevention of Damage of Public Property Act, 1984, and Sections 148, 440 and 427 IPC added later on registered at Police Station Banga, District Nawanshahar, and further to admit the petitioners on bail, in the event of their appearance before the learned trial Court.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the petition qua petitioner No.2-Baljit Kumar.

Ordered accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 18.04.2022, petitioner No. 1 appeared before the learned trial Court on 16.05.2022 and placed on record the receipt of Rs. 50,000/- of costs.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of, as the order dated 18.04.2022 has been complied with by petitioner No.1.
