Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.265 dated 06.10.2008 registered under Sections 307, 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Division No.5, Civil Lines, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner appeared before the Court concerned and has been released on interim bail in compliance of previous order dated 09.05.2022 passed by this Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertion made by the counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, as the petitioner has joined the proceedings with the trial Court.

Thus, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and order of interim bail dated 09.05.2022 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further, the petitioner should appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing.
