By this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ of 'mandamus' directing the respondents to decide his representation dated 19.12.2021 (copy Annexure P-7), as also his long pending claim for allotment of the shop/booth in the Motor Market Complex, Chandigarh.

Naturally, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his argument to the prayer made in the petition.

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision by passing a speaking order on the representation made by the petitioner (Annexure P-7), within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If there is any issue of delay etc., obviously that would also be taken into consideration by the concerned authority.
