1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.4 dated 06.01.2020 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 472, 474 IPC at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.
2. By an order dated 01.09.2021, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.
