Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0023 dated 24.02.2021 under Sections 3, 4 & 5 of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956, registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Pathankot.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 28.10.2021: -

“...Perusal of the FIR indicates that three ladies were apprehended from the ground-floor of the petitioner's house. There is no mention of any customer being apprehended nor there is any independent witness to the alleged occurrence. The raid in itself

was conducted on the basis of a secret information...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 28.10.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
