The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.53 dated 16.03.2021 registered under Section 354-A IPC and Section 67 of IT Act, at Police Station Samrala, District Khanna.

By virtue of the order dated 25.03.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.
