By this petition filed under the provisions of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners have prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus issuing a direction to the respondents to provide them two *karam rasta* as per clause 1(iii) of the policy dated 08.03.2019 (Annexure P-8), so that the petitioners can use their unacquired land situated in village Basai, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that they would be satisfied if a decision is taken on the representation dated 30.06.2014 (Annexure P-3) by the competent authority amongst the respondents, by passing a speaking order.

On advance notice being received, Mr. Chauhan submits that in fact the respondents have already given a passage to facilitate easement to the plots of all concerned; and in fact the petitioners having subsequently bought a piece of land, if any easementary right is to be sought by them, it would be from the person from whom they had purchased the land and not from the respondents herein.

Obviously all that would be taken into consideration by the competent authority by taking a decision on the representation (Annexure P-3).

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the representation (Annexure P-3) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order.
