Complaining violation of directions issued by the Court in CWP-21255-2021, titled as “Suraj Bhan and others Vs. State of Haryana and another”, dated 14.10.2021, the petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part of the order reads as under:-

“Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide legal notice dated 28.08.2021 (Annexure P7), if any, by passing a speaking order, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mr.Rajesh Nehra, Superintendent, PRT (ART), Branch office of Directorate of Elementary Education and Mr.Sandeep Kumar, Legal Assistant, submits that as directed by the Court on 14.10.2021, two speaking orders dated 05.01.2022 and 22.04.2022 qua petitioners No.6 and 8 have been passed, respectively and

compliance report qua rest of the petitioners has been submitted. A copy of the same has been placed on the case file.

Keeping in view the aforesaid, no further orders are required to be passed.
