This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 237 dated 30.12.2015 registered under Sections 323, 148, 149, 341 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 365 IPC added later on) at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1) and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

On 12.03.2020, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had directed the parties to get their statements recorded. As per the report submitted by the Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bathinda, the parties have not put in appearance to get their statements recorded.

In view of the same, present petition is dismissed.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to file a fresh petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise in case the compromise is effected between the parties and they are willing to get their statements recorded.
