Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 37 dated 12.02.2022, registered under Sections 506 IPC and Section 3(1)(r) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act 1989, at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

Vide order dated 28.03.2022, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 28.03.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Kamaljit Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 28.03.2022 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
