The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 18.04.2018 (Annexure P-1) vide which the Additional Sessions Judge, Hisar, has granted anticipatory bail to respondent No.1.

None appears for the petitioner.

The learned counsel for respondent No.1 submits that as many as 05 out of 11 prosecution witnesses already stand examined. It may also be relevant to mention here that respondent No.1 was granted the concession of anticipatory bail way back on 18.04.2018 and in the last four and a half years, no untoward incident has taken place between the parties.

In view of the above, there is no merit in the present petition and, therefore, the same is dismissed.
