Through this petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.18 dated 30.01.2020, registered under Sections 22, 25 and 29 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar (Rural).

Status report by way of affidavit dated 26.10.2022 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Shahkot, District Jalandhar (Rural) submitted by the learned State counsel in the Court, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR was registered on 30.01.2020 and since then the petitioner has been in custody. The charges were framed on 11.02.2021 but out of 10 prosecution witnesses, only 03 have been examined till now. At this stage, he restricts his prayer to the extent of issuance of direction to the learned trial Court to conclude the trial within a stipulated period.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court, to make an endeavour to conclude the trial at the earliest in accordance with law.
