1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 29.09.2021, in CWP-8706-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 29.09.2021 reveals that CWP-8706-2020 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider legal notice dated 22.10.2019, as representation filed by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within one month and in case the petitioners were found entitled to the relief claimed and there was no impediment for releasing the same, to release the same to them without any delay in accordance with law.

3. Notice has not yet been issued in the instant case.

4. However, learned AAG, Punjab, has produced copy of speaking order dated 09.02.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioners.

for the petitioners who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioners do not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 09.02.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
