Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in FIR No.34 dated 13.2.2021 registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station, Lehra, District Sangrur.

By virtue of the order dated 27.8.2021 while granting interim protection the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that in pursuance to the order dated 27.8.2021, the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
