AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition was filed seeking quashing of FIR No. 178 dated 3.9.2018, under Sections 336, 427, 506, 341, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar on the basis of compromise.

On 13.3.2020, notice of motion was issued and the parties were directed to appear before the trial court/ Illaqa Magistrate for recording of their statements with regard to compromise.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners.

The State has produced copy of order dated 11.9.2020 passed by Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar. The same is quoted below:

“Complainant Surinder Singh has suffered a statement in the court that he has no objection if the untrace/cancellation report presented by the police official is accepted by the Hon'ble court. Further complainant was identified by ASI Yusaf Masih.

In view of the statement of the complainant the present untrace/cancellation report is accepted and the Ahlmad is directed to separate the judicial papers from the police papers and then police papers be sent to the quarter concern and judicial file be consigned to the record room.”

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Needless to say that in case of any factual discrepancy, the petitioners would be at liberty to move an application for re-calling of the order.
