Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.13 dated 09.02.2020, registered for offences under Sections 342, 376 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Women, Kaithal, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of affidavit dated 20.02.2020, Annexure P-2.

Upon instructions from L/ASI Manjeet Kaur, State counsel has opposed the petition and submitted that the petitioner has been specifically named in the FIR as well as in the statement recorded by the prosecutrix under Section 164, Cr.P.C.. Upon further instructions, he submits that after the conclusion of the investigation, final report has been presented and charge has been framed against the petitioner under Section 376 (2) (n), 342 and 506, IPC.

Having considered the matter and in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in *The State of Madhya Pradesh Versus Laxmi Narayan and others 2019 (5) SCC 688*, this petition cannot be entertained and is ordered to be dismissed.
