On 28.03.2022, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with the complainant on 26.04.2018. The matrimonial dispute had cropped up between the parties. However, the matter has now been amicably settled. The petitioner and the complainant have instituted a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act for dissolution of marriage by mutual consent wherein statements of the parties at the stage of first motion have already been recorded.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Zorawar Singh Chauhan, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and affirmed the fact of compromise.

Mr. Munish Kumar Garg, Advocate, also accepts notice on behalf of the complainant.

Adjourned to 29.04.2022.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting

Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On instructions from ASI Sulekha, learned State counsel has not assailed the aforesaid factual aspects and states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the order dated 28.03.2022, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.
