1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 14.12.2021, in CWP-25335-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 14.12.2021, reveals that CWP-25335-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider legal notice dated 30.10.2020 as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if the petitioner was found entitled and there was no impediment for release of payment, to release the same to the petitioner as per law without any delay.

3. Learned Addl. AG, Punjab, has filed reply on behalf of respondent No.2 along with order Annexure R/1 dated 23.05.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated

30.10.2020. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 23.05.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
