Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking issuance of directions to official respondents No.1 to 4 to add the names of respondents No.6 to 8 as co-accused in FIR No.32 dated 14.03.2020 registered for offences under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station - Women, Chandigarh. A direction has also been sought to the official respondents No.1 to 4 to decide the representation dated 01.03.2021 submitted by the petitioner, Annexure P-9.

Prayer in the application (CRM-1190-2022) is for withdrawal of the main case, which is fixed for 31.03.2022.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that a compromise dated 28.10.2021, Annexure P-10, has been effected between the parties. He submits that the petitioner has filed an affidavit accompanying the application. He seeks permission to withdraw the main petition,

On an oral request made by the counsel for the petitioner, the hearing of the main case is postponed to today and is ordered to be taken up on Board.

On the basis of prayer made in the application (CRM-1190-2022), which is supported by the affidavit of petitioner No.1, counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the main petition.
