Counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not wish to press the present petition. It is a matter of fact that the benefit of pension has been extended to him, on account of the decision of the Apex Court in ‘Assistant General Manager, State Bank of India and others Vs. Radhey Shyam Pandey’ 2020 (2) SCT 305, wherein employees who had completed 15 years of service or more on the cut-off-date were held entitled for proportionate pension under SBI VRS to be computed as per SBI Pension Fund Rules. The said benefit was to be extended to all such similar employees.

Keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is disposed as having been rendered infructuous.
