Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0222 dated 27.11.2019, under Section 304-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar (Rural).

Vide order dated 24.08.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 24.08.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Premjit Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 24.08.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.

In view of the fact that the main petition has been allowed, CRM No.5526 of 2021 moved for vacation of stay is rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
