[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 30.11.2021 in CWP-PIL No.185 of 2021 in case titled as 'Manphool Singh versus State of Haryana and another.'

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP-PIL No.185 of 2021 was disposed of by taking note of the statement of the learned Addl. A.G., Haryana that representation dated 11.10.2021 filed by the petitioner would be considered and decided by the respondent-authorities in accordance with law.

[3] Learned DAG, Haryana, by referring to Annexure R-3 dated 04.04.2022 states that order of Hon'ble the Division Bench in CWP-PIL No.185 of 2021 has been complied with in view of decision taken on the representation of the petitioner dated 11.10.2021 and that in the circumstances, no action is called for against the respondents under the

Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner on perusal of the reply states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order (Annexure R-3) dated 04.04.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[5] The aforementioned course of action is not opposed to by the learned State Counsel.

[6] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
