The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.51 dated 31.03.2020 registered under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 and 34 IPC at Women Police Station Faridabad, District Faridabad and all subsequent proceedings arising out of it on the basis of a compromise deed dated 21.12.2020 (Annexure P-2).

On 01.04.2021 this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Area Magistrate/Trial Court upto 17.05.2021 for recording of their respective statements with regard to the compromise/settlement, who in turn was directed to submit a report along with the recorded statements with regard to the veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties as also to apprise this Court if is any other person involved in the occurrence, who is not a party to the present petition.

As directed, report dated 18.05.2021 from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad, has been received, as per which the

parties had recorded their statements before the Trial Court in terms of the compromise arrived at between them and no other person involved in the occurrence.

Learned State counsel has also raised no objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the above, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance of the afore-referred FIR which originates from a matrimonial dispute and the matter having been compromised, would be an abuse of the process of law and in terms of the law laid down by a Full Bench of this Court in Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal), 1052, this Court deems it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash the FIR No.51 dated 31.03.2020 registered under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 and 34 IPC at Women Police Station Faridabad, District Faridabad and all proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioner.
