This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 112 dated 09.11.2016 under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Division 3, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising on the basis of the compromise.

On 04.05.2018, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had issued notice of motion and also directed the parties to record their statements qua compromise. As per the report received by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana dated 03.08.2018, the parties had not appeared to get their statements recorded. Thereafter, the matter was adjourned on two dates. Today also, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to pursue the present petition.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sahib

Singh, has submitted that the cancellation report was submitted in the present case and the said cancellation report has been approved on 12.12.2018 and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives in the present petition and in case the compromise is still effective.
