Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to remove anomaly in pay scale within the department by granting grade pay of Rs.3000/- instead of Rs.2400/-.

At the outset, learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioners submitted that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case the legal notice dated 07.1.2022 (P-10) is decided expeditiously.

Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-The Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 07.01.2022 (P-10)

in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of 04 (four) months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
