Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to official respondents to take appropriate action against respondent No. 4 on the representation dated 05.10.2018 given by the petitioner.

As per submissions made in the representation/complaint, it is stated that the petitioner was selling the crops to respondent No. 4, who is a commission agent, however, respondent No. 4 refused to pay him the sale proceeds of Rs. 22 Lakh.

In para 7 of the representation/complaint, it is stated that a compromise was effected between the parties, wherein respondent No. 4 has acknowledged an amount of Rs. 22 Lakh, however, since the amount was not paid by respondent No. 4, the said complaint was given by the petitioner to police.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and going through

the said representation/complaint, this Court finds that the matter is of purely civil nature and the petitioner has an efficacious remedy of filing a suit for recovery.

In view of the same, the present petition is dispose of with liberty to petitioner to avail his alternative remedy in accordance with law.
