The petitioners have acquired two years Diploma in Veterinary Sciences from respondent No.2 in the years 2008 and earlier. Allegedly, the said diplomas are not being recognized as the Central Government has not taken appropriate action. Thus, representations dated 15.11.2019 (Annexure P-4) and dated 03.02.2020 (Annexure P-4 colly) have been submitted but no action has been taken. Thus, it is prayed that a direction be issued to the Union of India to decide the pending representations by passing a speaking order.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, no reply is necessary.
