Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the selection/appointment of the post of Veterinary & Livestock Development Assistant including respondent No.4 made by the office of respondent No.3 and further directing the official respondents to select the petitioner against the said posts after adopting the proper criteria for giving weightage of higher percentage of marks as well as experience.

2. Petition was filed in the year 2001 and was admitted for hearing on 01.04.2002. When taken up for final adjudication, Mr. C.S. Singh, Advocate appears and submits that he does not have instructions. He states that he is appearing out of his moral duty as the professional courtesy. Learned counsel, who filed the petition, was known to him and he expired during the pendency of the writ proceedings. He submits that he will contact the petitioner and in case the petitioner is interested to pursue his cause, appropriate application alongwith affidavit of the petitioner would be filed to seek the revival of the writ petition.

3. Be that as it may, it seems that by sheer effluxion of time and pendency of the writ petition for more than 21 years before this Court, it has been

rendered infructuous and/or the petitioner seems to have lost interest in pursuing the same.

4. Be that as it may, writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application in case, any cause of action still survives.
