Petition herein is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to transfer her to Narnaul District Mohindergarh against the vacancy as per the exemption clause 13 para 7 of the online transfer policy dated 15.11.2018 (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner qua his aforesaid grievance submitted a representation dated 06.01.2022 (Annexure P-4) but the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date. Hence, the instant petition.

3. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and opposes issuance of notice of motion and submits that competent authority shall take decision either way, on the pending representation of the petitioner, in due course.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner also agrees that let a final decision be taken, by the competent authority on the pending representation of the petitioner.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as per representation dated 06.01.2022 (Annexure P-4) and also contentions raised in the present petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and take a decision, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible but not later than 03 months from today.

7. Disposed of accordingly.
