This common order shall dispose of the above-mentioned three criminal miscellaneous petitions as the prayer made in all the petitions is to quash the order dated 15.12.2017 (Annexure P-8), passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, prays for withdrawal
