This is a criminal writ petition that has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Habeas Corpus* for the release of the detenues as mentioned in para 4 of the petition as being illegally detained by respondents No.4 and 5.

Notice of motion was issued in the matter and respondent No.2-District Magistrate, Jhajar was directed to get the premises of respondent No.4 searched or any other place as pointed out by the petitioner and to find out whether such persons have been illegally detained there or not and if so, get them released immediately.

Reply has been filed by the respondent-State, which is taken on record.

As per the reply filed by way of affidavit of District Magistrate, Jhajjar, the premises of the brick kiln were visited and they were informed

that the labourers, as mentioned in para 4 of the petition, have already left the brick kiln on their own account and wages, as fixed by the government, had been paid.

Counsel for the petitioner, who has filed the instant petition, has not put in an appearance on 28.07.2021 as well as on 15.11.2021.

When this matter is taken up today, again no one has put in an appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Consequently, this court is constrained to dismissed the instant petition for want of prosecution.
