This petition by virtue of Section 439 (2) Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner/complainant-Balbir Singh seeking cancellation of the bail order dated 18.08.2020 (Annexure P-1) allowing bail to respondent No.2-Rohitash Singh in a case bearing FIR No.346 dated 23.12.2019 under Section 406 IPC registered at Police Station, Sector 37, Gurugram.

Heard.

This Court while allowing anticipatory bail under

Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the accused/Rohitash Singh had observed that the case harbours on the fringe of criminal and civil liabilities which can only be adjudicated at the time of the trial. The present petition for cancellation is purely on the grounds that the complainant apprehends threat to his life and property at the hands of this accused. The allegations are highly vague and ambiguous without finer details and rather appear to be with the intent to facilitate cancellation of the bail.

Apparently, there appears to be no violation of the terms of the bail order nor any likelihood of misuse of the bail is either pleaded or *prima facie* made out.

The petition being hopelessly without merits stands dismissed in *limine*.
